



CURRENCY RULES

The following are the currency rules which are in place at Genesis Flight Centre for all rental aircraft. Occasionally, exceptions may be permitted providing the exception falls within the limits of the overriding insurance policy. All exemptions must be authorized by the Chief Flight Instructor or President.

IN ALL CASES, as a minimum you must have flown the specific type of aircraft within the past 60 days in order to be current on that type. A full checkout must be completed and signed off by an instructor before renting any aircraft for solo flight. Licenced pilots and permit holders must complete a flight that is at least 0.5 in duration in order to be current.

- Completed applicable checkout procedure (5 hour course for new customers)
- Flown the Company's aircraft for at least 0.5 hours in the previous 30 days
- If it has been more than 30 days since you last flew the Company's aircraft, but less than 60 days, a circuit check is required.
- If over 60 days have lapsed, a complete checkout is required.
- Student pilots, night rating students, and anyone with less than 100 hours require a complete checkout if more than 14 days have lapsed.

ALL RENTERS

- Flying the DA20 does not maintain currency on any other aircraft type.
- Flying the DA40 does not maintain currency on any other aircraft type.
- Flying the C172N does maintain currency on the C150, provided an initial full checkout on each type has been completed.
- Flying the C150 does maintain currency on the C172N, provided an initial full checkout on each type has been completed.

Currency cards will only be updated at the completion of 0.5 or more of Hobbs time.

Authorization of all flights are at the discretion of the instructor on duty pending other variables (eg. wind conditions etc.).

All pilots who do not meet the above requirements will be required to complete a currency check out ride with a Genesis instructor. Duration of this flight is at the discretion of the instructor on duty.
