- 2. All Program cost and fee estimates are primarily based on the minimum number of training hours prescribed by Transport Canada, existing fuel prices and instructor rates, and exclude HST. Aircraft and instructor rates may change by up to 50% to reflect current service delivery costs such as maintenance and fuel price fluctuations).
- 3. Most students complete the Program in the minimum number of training hours. Weather, airport traffic constraints, the student's learning capabilities, etc. may all result in more training time being required (see Optional Fees).
- 4. Should a student fail to cancel with at least 24 hours prior notice, arrive late or "no-show" for a booking, a fee of \$100 for an aircraft cancellation failure and/or \$100 for an instructor cancellation failure will be charged.
